THREE PENALTIES TO A PLAYER DURING A GAME

Application

Single letter minor hockey in region of Richelieu only

Three penalties to a player during a game

Any player that receives three (3) penalties of any type during the same game will receive an expulsion from the game immediately following the third penalty. The player must proceed directly to his locker room for the remainder of the game. The player is not suspended from future games unless the third penalty given merits a suspension.

When a team receives a bench penalty, the penalty must be served by a player on the ice at the time of the infraction. This penalty served does NOT count toward the three (3) allowed infractions for the player serving the bench penalty, unless this player is the cause of the bench minor.

The coach must choose a player on the ice at the time of the third infraction to serve the penalty in the box.

NB : A double minor for spearing will count as one (1) infraction; this is also true for « hit to the head » and « 6-inch end butt ».
